Replicator - Silencer Summit 2025 Write-up - 5.56 mm

This document is a brief overview of Replicator Suppressors (labeled as RR Weapons on the Silencer Summit website) and how they stack up when compared to somewhat similar suppressors. Full results are here: https://thunderbeastarms.com/sound/summit2025/

Full results are confusing for many people, so we have pared down some of the data in order to give you and customers in an easily digestible format. We have sections for general performance, length, and weight.

Notes:

- Most manufacturers measure A-weighted decibels 1 meter left of the muzzle (ML dBA). This is a decent measurement to show the sound coming from the side of the firearm.
- Another useful measurement is decibels at the shooter's ear. (SE dBA)
- Leq is interesting as it gives an average over 10ms, giving you an idea of exposure

The Ventus is our free-flow flagship product and is an all-around excellent performer. The Ventus 556 is incredibly pleasant to shoot for you and everyone around. For a .30 caliber suppressor on a 5.56 host, the Ventus 30 performs excellent as well:

The Chode is our brand new super short free-flow, extreme duty use design. It is shorter than anything that was tested and if you sort against the next few by length, we are beating in almost every category! Muzzle Left was kept in the table, but the crazy thing is that this is actually really pleasant to shoot. Look at Shooter's Ear and see what I mean:

The Ventus K is also new, and again, same free-flow extreme duty design. It's a bit louder at muzzle left than some other products we have, but it may just be the quietest at shooter's ear for this style of can. It's weird as a shooter when you see a higher number for muzzle left, but then you shoot it and it doesn't sound or feel that loud. Nothing can really replace the shooting experience, but you can see why a lot of people absolutely love this little guy - the SE ratings. He's short, too - just not as short as the Chode but even lighter.
